<p>Food and household organic material, Tea bags, coffee filters</p> <p>Used kitchen paper, napkins</p> <p>Diapers</p> <p>Shoes</p> <p> <b>NOT</b> hazardous waste.</p> <p> <b>NOT</b> electrical appliances.</p> <p><b>NOT</b> light bulbs and fluorescent tubes.</p>	<p>Cardboard and paper</p> <p>Small cardboard boxes from food packaging</p> <p>Drink packaging</p> <p>Office paper, envelopes</p> <p>Empty toilet paperrolls empty kitchen paperrolls</p>	<p>Food packaging of glass and metal, like jam jars</p> <p>Drink packaging of glass and metal</p> <p>Aluminiumfoil</p> <p><b>NOT</b> porcelain, pottery crystal, drinking glass, mirrors, refractory glass or windows.</p>	<p>Plastic bags</p> <p>Plastic packaging used for food</p> <p>Potato chips bags, coffee bags</p> <p>Plastic cup, -can, -jugs</p> <p>Flowerpot of plastic</p> <p>Plastic bottles</p> <p><b>NOT</b> packaging used for hazardous waste.</p> <p><b>NOT</b> polystyrene.</p> <p><b>NOT</b> firewood sacks</p>
<p><b>REMEMBER</b> <i>It will be easier to clean the waste container if you put the waste in plastic bags.</i></p>	<p><b>REMEMBER</b> <i>Not to use plastic bags!</i></p>	<p><b>REMEMBER</b> <i>Not to use plastic bags!</i></p>	<p><b>REMEMBER</b> <i>To clean plastic packaging with cold water.</i></p> <p><i>To use only perforated sack. Put it on yellow hook on pickup day.</i></p>
