

Once a week we collect waste from your home. The calendar shows the type of waste we collect during the week concerned. Household waste is sorted into four categories: refuse, glass and metal packaging, paper/cardboard/cartons, and household plastic. Household plastic must be delivered for collection in a special bag that is hung on a yellow hook on the bin for paper/cardboard/cartons. Sorting waste is necessary to make space for normal household

waste. We will not collect any waste placed outside of the bins. On collection day, the waste bin must be placed a maximum of 5 metres from where the waste collection vehicle stops. Snow must be removed so that it is easy for those manning the vehicle to move the bin. Sand etc. must be strewed when it is icy.

This is the equipment everyone should have. The red box is for collection of hazardous waste such as batteries, paint, light bulbs and small electronic devices. When the box is full, take it to your local waste reception station. If you are missing some of this equipment, contact us.

All other waste may be delivered free of charge to your local waste reception station. Examples of this are furniture, large cardboard packaging, metal, electrical products, construction waste, garden waste etc., and hazardous waste such as paint, batteries, and light bulbs etc.

## Recycling guide – what and how?

REFUSE	PAPER AND CARDBOARD	HOUSEHOLD PLASTIC	GLASS/METAL PACKAGING
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Food waste</li> <li>Teabags</li> <li>Coffee filters</li> <li>Used kitchen paper and napkins</li> <li>Nappies</li> <li>Clothes, shoes</li> <li>Pot plants/flowers</li> </ul> <p>Place refuse in tied bags; this will facilitate easier cleaning of the carting bin.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Paper, newspapers and paper advertisements</li> <li>Small cardboard boxes</li> <li>Milk and juice cartons</li> <li>Cardboard from food packaging</li> <li>Office paper, Envelopes</li> <li>Cardboard rolls from paper towelling</li> </ul> <p>These should be disposed of loose in the bin. Do not use plastic or paper bags for this waste as it destroys automatic sorting.</p> <p>No hard-cover books.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Plastic bags, bags and foil from packaged products such as plastic bread bags, sandwich packaging, etc.</li> <li>Plastic bottles and containers for food, cleaning agents and grooming products etc.</li> <li>Plastic bottles for beverages excepting deposit bottles. Yoghurt and sour cream containers etc.</li> <li>Trays, cups and packaging for fruit, vegetables and meat products.</li> <li>Flowerpots and trays: These should be rinsed and disposed of in perforated bags that are hung on the paper bin on collection day.</li> <li>Dirty plastic is disposed of in refuse.</li> <li>No packaging that has contained hazardous waste, no hard plastic or firewood sacks. These should be delivered to your local waste reception station.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Glass packaging such as jam jars with lids</li> <li>Glass bottles and metal cans for drinks</li> <li>Cans for food</li> <li>Aluminium foil and containers</li> <li>Should be disposed of loose in the bin. Using plastic or paper bags for this waste destroys automatic sorting.</li> <li>No porcelain, ceramics, crystal, drinking glasses, mirrors, oven dishes or windows.</li> <li>These should be delivered to your local waste reception station.</li> </ul>
