



Information about waste and recycling

We collect some kind of waste from your home almost every week. The calendar below shows what type of waste collect each week.

HOUSEHOLD WASTE IS SORTED INTO FIVE CATEGORIES:

- food waste
- glass and metal packaging
- paper/cardboard/cartons
- plastic packaging
- general waste (refuse)

Sorting waste is important in order to reduce our negative environmental impact and to make the best use of resources already produced. It is also necessary in order to ensure you have enough space in your bins.

You should have access to a rubbish bin for each of the categories listed, except plastic packaging which you put in the designated bags we provide you with.

It is important that only biobags are used for food waste. If you need more bio-bags, simply tie a bag onto your food waste bin, and we will leave new bags for you. It is also possible to get bio-bags at your local waste reception centre or at the municipality's service centre.










You can also request a red box for hazardous waste such as batteries, paint, light bulbs, and small electronic devices. When the box is full, take it to your local waste reception centre.











You can also bring most other types of waste to your local waste reception centre free of charge. For example, furniture, large cardboard packages, metal, electrical products, construction waste, garden waste, etc.

We will not collect any waste placed outside the bins. On collection day, the bin must be placed within a maximum of five metres where the waste collection vehicle stops. Snow must be cleared in the winter so that we can easily move the bin. Grit must be put down if it is icy. In the summer, vegetation and grass must not be an obstacle for the bins or the vehicle.









Waste collection schedule July - December 2026













 ** Monday route - Flå: Route 7 from the border with Nesbyen to the roundabout at Bjørneparken, including Stavngutu, Stavnsvegen and Øygardsvegen.
 *** Monday route - Krødsherad: West side, from Kryllingheimen - Ringnes - Bråstua crossroads.
 **** Wednesday Route - Krødsherad: Hamremoens - Krøderen - Sigdal border.
 ***** Friday Route - Krødsherad: Flå border - Hamremoens roundabout - Redalen - Havikskogen.



RECYCLING POINTS

The recycling points are intended solely for holiday homes and the small number of permanent residents whose waste is not collected from their property. Other residents are not permitted to use the recycling points. It is also prohibited to leave waste outside the underground waste containers or skips at the recycling points.

Waste that is not collected in household bins or deposited in the waste containers at the recycling points must be taken to the recycling centres.

All of our customers may dispose of waste at the recycling centres free of charge, as this service is included in the waste collection fee.

Milk and juice cartons



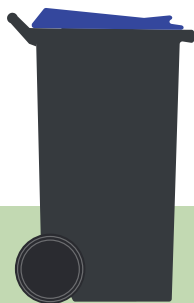
Office paper, envelopes



Pizza, yogurt, cereal boxes



Empty paper towel rolls and toilet paper rolls



To be disposed of loosely in the bin for cardboard and paper.



GLASS AND METAL PACKAGING



Jam jars



Glass bottles



Metal cans for food and toppings



Aluminum foil and moulds



No-deposit drinks cans



Metal caps and lids



To be disposed of loosely in the bin for glass and metal.

Bags

If you need more bio bags, tie a bag to the bin for the next collection. You can also pick them up at recycling stations or municipal service centres. Bags for plastic packaging are distributed once a year.

5 metres

Place bins no more than five metres from the side of the road that the collection vehicle will drive along to empty them.

06.00

If you want to be sure your bins will be emptied, put them out by 06.00.
